Sub: Consolidated Scrutinizer's Report on remote e-voting conducted pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended, and Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ('SEBI Listing Regulations') for the 71st Annual General Meeting of WPIL Limited held on Friday, August 08, 2025 at 11.00 a.m. (IST) through video conferencing ("VC") / other audio visual means ("OAVM").

I, P. V. Subramanian, Practicing Company Secretary, was appointed as the Scrutinizer by the Board of Directors of **WPIL Limited** ("the Company") pursuant to Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended, to conduct the remote e-voting process (conducted before as well as during the AGM) in respect of the below mentioned resolutions proposed at the 71st Annual General Meeting ("AGM") of **WPIL Limited** held today i.e. Friday, August 08, 2025 at 11.00 a.m. (IST) through VC/ OAVM.

The Notice dated May 23, 2025, convening the AGM along with the 71st Annual Report & Accounts for FY 2024-2025, as confirmed by the Company, was sent to the shareholders in respect of the below mentioned resolutions passed at the AGM of the Company through electronic mode to those Members whose email addresses were registered with the Company/ Registrar and Transfer Agent/ Depositories/ Depository Participants in compliance with the MCA General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated April 08, 2020, 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, 20/2020 dated May 05, 2020, and subsequent circulars issued in this regard, the latest being General Circular No. 09/2024 dated September 19, 2024 (collectively referred to as 'MCA Circulars') and Securities and

Exchange Board of India (SEBI) Circulars dated May 12, 2020, January 15, 2021, May 13, 2022, January 05, 2023, October 06, 2023, October 07, 2023 and October 03, 2024 (SEBI Circulars).

The Company had availed the e-voting facility offered by National Securities Depository Limited ("NSDL") for conducting remote e-voting by the Shareholders of the Company prior to the Meeting as well as during the Meeting.

The voting period for remote e-voting prior to the AGM commenced on Tuesday, August 05, 2025 at 09.00 a.m. (IST) and ended on Thursday, August 07, 2025 at 05.00 p.m. (IST) and the NSDL e-voting platform was disabled thereafter.

The Company had also provided e-voting facility during the AGM to those shareholders who were present at the AGM through VC/ OAVM and who had not cast their vote(s) earlier through remote e-voting.

The shareholders of the Company holding shares as on the "cut-off" date of August 01, 2025 were entitled to vote on the resolutions as contained in the Notice of the AGM.

After the closure of the e-voting at the AGM, the report on remote voting done during the AGM and the votes cast under remote e-voting facility prior to the AGM were unblocked by me in the presence of two persons who acted as witnesses as prescribed under sub-rule 4(xii) of Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended.

I have scrutinized and reviewed the remote e-voting process prior to and during the AGM and votes cast therein based on the data downloaded from the NSDL e-voting system.

The Management of the Company is responsible to ensure compliance with the requirements of the Act and rules relating to remote e-voting prior to and during the AGM on the resolutions contained in the notice of the AGM.

My responsibility as scrutinizer for the remote e-voting is restricted to making a Scrutinizer's Report of the votes cast in favour or against the resolutions.
